



- ✓ Absorb Impact (lbf): Reduces impacts by at least 75%
- ✓ Adapts to Fit (in): 40% reduction of movement during contact
- Maintain Shape (in³): No change in volume

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

Collarbone fractures Rib fractures AC joint injuries Rotator cuff Shoulder separation Shoulder dislocation







The padding on the shoulder and neck is made of shredded gel memory foam, polyurethane foam, all wrapped in ultraweather resistant nylon fabric sheet.

Reduce shoulder pad displacement by 45.4% after impact compared to a tshirt undershirt.

Secure fit football undershirt protects the neck from impact and decreases the motion of shoulder pads.
